



Comparing Environments - Teacher's Notes

Students are asked to consider changing landscapes. Encompassed in this topic is the concept of Constructed, Managed and Natural environments. This enables students to describe how one landscape has changed over time, for example from a natural landscape to a constructed landscape, such as bushland being cleared for houses.

Materials

- Student worksheet
- Red, blue and green pencils

Student Activity (with worksheet)

1. Draw a line to match the key word to its meaning:

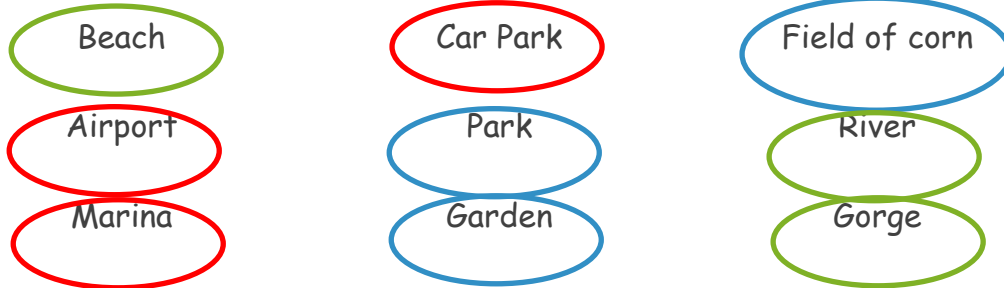
Constructed landscape		A space created by nature.
Managed landscape		A space made by humans.
Natural landscape		Somewhere created by nature but tended/controlled by humans.
